## Cabinet nod to new tourism policy

Ranchi: The state cabinet chaired by chief minister Raghubar Das on Tuesday gave its nod to the new state tourism policy and formation of an eco-tourism board to promote tourism in Jharkhand.

The new policy will promote several forms of tourism in Jharkhand and will attempt to draw private investments in the sector by providing tax exemptions and incentives in infrastructure development. "The policy will have set of guidelines for tourism companies and hoteliers which will have to be adhered to," principal secretary Avinash Kumar said after the meeting.

The cabinet also roped in New Delhi-based NGO Indian Trust for Rural Heritage Development (ITRHD) for restoration of the terracotta temple complex site in Maluti village in Dumka. The ITRHD had proposed a conservation plan worth Rs 9 crore to the erstwhile Arjun Munda government in 2011. The government will enter into a MoU with the organization.

The cabinet also made biometric attendance for government employees mandatory. This apart, the cabinet also allotted 1,000 acres of land for free to Indian Agriculture Research Institute in Hazaribag. TNN
